DIRECTIONS: Exit 14 off I-5: **River S Unit:** west 2.5 miles to Hillhurst (9th) Ave, left for 3/4 mile to River S. Unit entrance, down hill across bridge to kiosk parking lot. All volunteers must sign a volunteer service agreement (if under 18 must be signed by parent or guardian) which can be found at:
